## **Instructions for sewing Wheelchair Pad Covers**

Whenever possible, make two pad covers of the same fabric. We often need two pads for a chair (one for the back and one for the seat) Matching sets (pad covers and bags) are VERY nice.

These covers are made to fit over a 2" thick foam pad. (You do not need to supply the foam pad.)

MEDIUM: (Make few)	LARGE: (most used size)
Fits a 16" x 16" foam pad	Fits a 16" x 18" foam pad
Cut fabric 44" long x 19" wide	Cut fabric 48" long x 19" wide

- 1. Hem 19" end with 1-1/4" hem (1/4" turn under, then 1" turn under).
- 2. Fold one hemmed end down 7" (right sides together, pin in place).
- 3. Fold other hemmed end over the 7" turndown to 2" top (right sides together, pin in place).
- 4. Sew 5/8" seam down both sides. If fabric ravels, zigzag seams.
- 5. Turn inside out and press.

## **Instructions for sewing Tie-On Bags for Back of Wheelchairs**

Use sturdy, washable fabric, the more colorful the better. Having a matching set (pad cover and bag) is great.

## For Bags:

SMALL:	Cut fabric 28" long x 15" wide.
LARGE: (most use	(most used) – Cut fabric 30" long x 17" wide.
	Hem both short ends (15" or 17") with $1-1/4$ " hem ( $1/4$ "
	turn under, then 1" turn under.

For Ties (4 for each bag): Cut four pieces of fabric 18" long x 2" wide.

- 1. Turn under one of the short ends of tie, and then fold fabric from both sides toward middle. Now fold in half and sew down long side.
- 2. To attach ties to bag: With bag fabric wrong side up, attach a tie at each corner of hem 1-1/2" inside. Sew securely.
- 3. Fold bag fabric in half, right sides together, pin and sew 5/8 seam down each side. Sew again or finish edges with zigzag. Turn and press.
