But Renatta and Melany are no longer infants. Their bodies are growing and so is their need for independence. Yet while their parents labor to keep food on the table, their income would never be enough to afford even one wheelchair for their girls, let alone two!

Your love and ministry partnership brought Renatta, Melany, and their whole family out of darkness and despair, giving them a future full of hope. When the twins' mother, Paulina, heard that our *Wheels for the World* team would be holding a wheelchair distribution in Guadalajara, she packed up her girls in their wornout infant stroller and headed our way.




