ur Wheels for the World team met Jacob and his parents, Julius and Katrina, during our outreach in Manila, Philippines. Doctors declared Jacob dead at birth, but his mother believed in miracles, and she begged God to give her baby life. "There was no breath in him at all," explains Katrina. "I cried out to the Lord, and ten minutes after he was born, Jacob took his first breath." No wonder Julius and Katrina call Jacob their "Miracle Boy!"

Jacob is now alive and well, bringing great joy to his parents and all who meet him. Still, the traumatic events surrounding his birth have left him severely disabled. He has athetoid cerebral palsy and his symptoms include abrupt, involuntary movements, tremors, and unsteadiness. His parents wanted Jacob to go to school, but once they brought him, he would just lie on the floor in the classroom. Jacob was in desperate need of a wheelchair.

Your love and ministry partnership gave Jacob a brand-new pediatric wheelchair. And not just any pediatric wheelchair: the new, highly specialized Cub wheelchair, which made its Joni and Friends debut during our *Wheels for the World* distribution in the Philippines.

In countries like the Philippines, families often don't have the luxury of utilizing accessible vans, so traditional pediatric wheelchairs are extremely difficult to transport. That's why the Cub wheelchair was designed to come apart easily so it can be loaded and transported with minimal effort. And in Manila, where motorized tricycles are a common mode of transportation, the Cub chair is definitely seen as a God-send!

"Not only is the Cub chair incredibly versatile and easy to tailor to the individual needs of its recipient," explains David, our *Wheels for the World* team member. "But it folds up and breaks down quickly and efficiently so it can be positioned on the back of a tricycle, carried up and down stairs, and fit through doorways without problems. It only took Julius a few minutes to learn how to adjust Jacob's new Cub chair." Both Julius and Katrina beamed with joy as they saw their sweet Miracle Boy placed in his new seat of dignity and mobility.

Julius and Katrina had been waiting for seven years for a wheelchair for Jacob. And today, because of your love wrapped in the Gospel, Jacob received a chair that perfectly fits his needs! No longer will he have to lay on the floor at school. "Now Jacob can fully participate in school," says our *Wheels for the World* occupational therapist, Jillian. "The table on his Cub chair makes it possible for Jacob to draw, play with toys, and learn to write. His new Cub chair allows Jacob to be as independent as possible. And this wheelchair will grow with Jacob!"



Yes, Jesus Wes Them

acob wasn't the only child blessed with a brand-new wheelchair during our *Wheels* for the World outreach in the Philippines. Prences was also lovingly fit into a wheelchair that was designed to meet her individual needs.

Although she is seventeen years old, Prences remains the size of a toddler. She is very thin and doesn't appear to have much muscle on her bones at all. Her parents don't know her diagnosis, but our therapists believe she may have cerebral palsy and scoliosis, among other disabilities.

"I have never seen someone whose body was contorted in every which way like hers," confesses

Evalerie, one of our *Wheels for the World* team members. "My heart just broke when I met Prences, and I wondered if we could help her... Would she even be able to sit in a wheelchair?"

As tender as our therapists were during Prences's wheelchair fitting, she whimpered and started to cry as our team gently massaged her stiff joints enough to fit her properly in her own pediatric Cub chair. "I started to sing to Prences and softly stroked her face," says Evalerie.

Jesus loves you this I know, for the Bible tells me so. Little ones to him belong; they are weak but he is strong...



And as Prences listened to this age-old lullaby about Jesus, her whimpers stopped.

God knows Prences by name, and he loves her deeply—just as he loves all of the other children we served at that *Wheels for the World* outreach.
