



Prayer Requests May 11 – May 17

Sunday 11 – Today, as many people celebrate Mother's Day, pray against discouragement for mothers who feel as though their sacrifices go unnoticed. Pray for those who are grieving, those who live with hope deferred (Proverbs 13:12), and those who long for reconciliation between mother and child.

Monday 12 – Pray for new In-Country Coordinators in [Central America](#) as they gain experience and wisdom to continue ministry in Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Mexico, and Nicaragua.

Pray for staff and volunteers who will implement these plans, that they will have discernment and patience to respond to unforeseen circumstances.

Wednesday 14 – Pray for people living with a disability who have lost hope and do not wish to continue living. Ask God to surround them with caring Christians who can share truth and encouragement, assuring them of God's purpose and plans, even when all seems bleak.

Thursday 15 – Today is Global Accessibility Awareness Day. Ask God to equip pastors and church leaders with a heart for accessibility and the wisdom to implement necessary accommodations so that churches become places of invitation and full inclusion for people with disabilities.

Friday 16 – [Our Mississippi office](#) is hosting a [Family Retreat for single parents](#) this weekend. Pray for these moms and dads to experience rest and a deeper understanding of the way God longs to comfort them with his grace and strength.

Saturday 17 – We have a [Wheels for the World](#)™ outreach in [Argentina](#) throughout next week. Ask God to keep staff and volunteers safe, giving them clarity and creativity in the process of fitting each person with the mobility equipment they need. Pray that recipients would have softened hearts to the Gospel message.
